We are very excited that we will be having an additional classroom added to our building to replace the very old mobile classroom at the back of school.

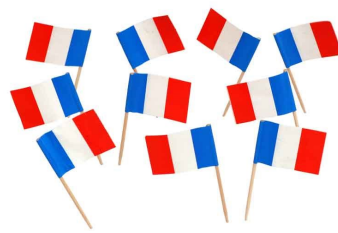
Work is likely to begin in the autumn and this will also enable us to develop the grounds and footpaths for better access to and from school.
