Behaviour and Attitudes

Our children are very well behaved. They follow the 'Woodhouse Way' and have the chance to receive a 'Woodhouse Wonder' badge for following the school values. Children also receive house points and award cards.



Children are encouraged to take on responsibilities and help others. For example they become prefects, house captains and reading buddies.

They are taught that it is ok to disagree, as long as they are not disagreeable!



Where behaviour is not as we would wish we work closely with children and parents. The children work through restorative practice to solve their problems or differences. Instances of bullying are very rare but always investigated thoroughly.



The Curriculum

Our Curriculum is carefully designed to meet the needs of all of our learners.

- Children get off to a 'flying start' in our excellent Early Years.
- There are well - structured programmes of learning in all subjects.
- A focus on reading and fostering a love of books.
- A 'mastery' approach to mathematics
- Thoughtfully planned trips and visits to deepen and extend understanding.
- Specialist teaching in French and sport
- Cross curricular links make learning more meaningful and the children are encouraged to think, ask questions and challenge themselves to develop their knowledge and understanding of the world around them.



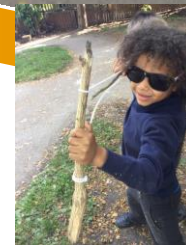
Our EYFS

Even though we are a relatively small school we do well in many Trafford school competitions, and we have even been known to win a few!



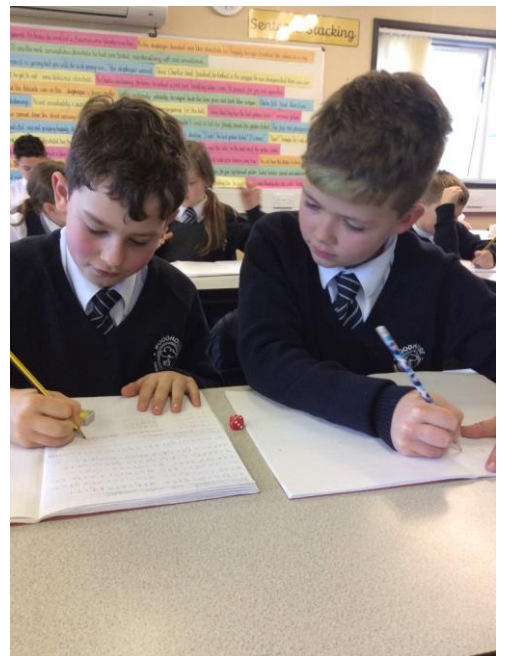
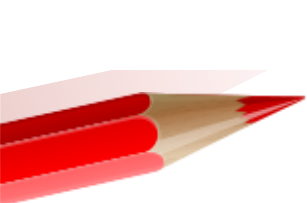
Our Environment

We have made significant improvements to our classrooms in recent years and are very fortunate to have extensive grounds.







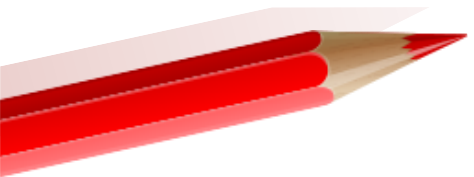


